**To: Chief Executive Officers of Pennsylvania State Chartered Banking and Trust Institutions**

To assist your institution in preparation of a schedule of holidays, below is a list of 2020 legal bank holidays as extracted from Section 113 of the Banking Code of 1965, as amended:

Fixed Holidays

January 1 – New Year’s Day

January 20 – Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day

May 25 – Memorial Day

July 4 – Independence Day

September 7 – Labor Day

November 26 – Thanksgiving Day

December 25 – Christmas Day

Optional Holidays

February 12 – Lincoln’s Birthday

February 17 – Washington’s Birthday

April 10 – Good Friday

June 14 – Flag Day

October 12 – Columbus Day

November 3 – Election Day

November 11 – Veterans’ Day

When a fixed holiday falls on a Sunday, it shall be observed on the following Monday; when it falls on a Saturday, it may also be observed on the following Monday.

Flag Day, June 14, falls on a Sunday in 2020. As optional holidays, there is no provision in the Banking Code to observe Flag Day on an alternate day.
